APPROVAL OF MAP 18839 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-19199

WATER DIVISION 1-D

BACKGROUND

1. On February 21, 2014, Lisa A. and Toby Vanschoiack filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-19199 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On May 9, 2014, Lisa A. and Toby Vanschoiack filed in the Department map number 18839 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-19199.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 18839 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-19199 as depicted on map number 8839 which is made a part of this Order.

Township 3 North, Range 7 East of the 6 <sup>th</sup> P.M. in Gage County	Acres
Section 30: SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$	31.5

3. Appropriation A-19199 has a priority date of February 21, 2014, and authorizes the appropriator the use of water for irrigation of the 39.5 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from the Big Blue River at a point of diversion located on the right bank of the stream in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 29, Township 3 North, Range 7 East of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Gage County, as depicted on map number 18839. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.56 cfs (251 gallons per minute).

4. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated nor the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry. Therefore, in any year when less than the maximum permitted acres are being irrigated, the quantity of water diverted at any time may be restricted to 1/70 cfs for each permitted acre being irrigated that year. This appropriation of water under any circumstance shall be limited annually to 3 acre-feet per acre of land on which water is actually and beneficially applied; not to exceed the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry.
5. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-19199.
