ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-10939

WATER DIVISION 2-F

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-10939 is held by James W. and Demarus K. Carlson, Trustees of the Carlson Family Trust.
2. The Department has received information that Demarus K. Carlson is deceased.
3. Appropriation A-10939 has a priority date of August 22, 1966, and authorizes the use of water for the washing of limestone aggregate, with the washing screen and settling basin located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12, Township 32 North, Range 3 West of the 6th P.M. in Knox County. The water may be diverted from Weigand Creek at a point of diversion located on the right bank of the stream in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12, Township 32 North, Range 3 West of the 6th P.M. in Knox County. The amount of water diverted shall not exceed 2.9 cubic feet per second (1,300 gallons per minute).
4. On January 30, 2015, James W. Carlson, Trustee of the Carlson Family Trust filed a Relinquishment of Water Appropriation, REL-5289, in the office of the Department relinquishing the right to divert water under appropriation A-10939.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED appropriation A-10939 is CANCELLED.
