APPROVAL OF EXPEDITED TRANSFER EXT-5487 AND MAP NUMBER 18104

FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-3632

WATER DIVISION 1-B

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-3632 is held by Donald E. and Aneta Harding.
2. Appropriation A-3632 has a priority date of August 21, 1943, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 76.5 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Medicine Creek at points of diversion located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 07, and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 18, all in Township 04 North, Range 25 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Furnas County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 201 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 0.38 cfs from all points of diversion.

3. Appropriations A-3701, A-6576A and A-11817A provide additional water to land approved for irrigation under appropriation A-3632.
4. On June 15, 2015, Donald E. and Aneta Harding filed application EXT-5487 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use for land authorized to be irrigated by appropriation A-3632 and map number 18104 showing the land proposed to be irrigated under appropriation A-3632 through transfer EXT-5487.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Application EXT-5487 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use and map number 18104 are APPROVED.

2. Appropriation A-3632 through transfer EXT-5487 authorizes the use of water to irrigate 76.5 acres of land described below and depicted on map number 18104, which is made a part of this Order. The water may be diverted from Medicine Creek at points of diversion located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 07, and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 18, all in Township 04 North, Range 25 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Furnas County, as depicted on map number 18104. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cfs for every 201 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 0.38 cfs from all points of diversion (171 gallons per minute). The total volume of appropriation A-3632 may not exceed 1.50 acre-feet per irrigated acre per year; not to exceed the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry.

3. All terms and conditions of appropriation A-3632 remain in effect unless specifically changed by this Order.
4. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. This includes, but is not limited to, the following:
- A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
  - B. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
  - C. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.

#### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION


Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations, any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources, or the provisions of this Approval may cause cancellation of part or all of this appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

Nebraska law provides that failure to use an appropriation for more than five consecutive years may result in cancellation of the appropriation.

This appropriation is not a guarantee that water will be available. Nebraska law gives priority to senior appropriations. This appropriation may be closed if there is insufficient water to satisfy senior appropriations.
