APPROVAL OF MAP 17453 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-18672

Background

1. On July 13, 2009, Joseph R. Wubben filed application A-18672 in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On August 3, 2009, Joseph R. Wubben filed map number 17453 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-18672.

Order

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 17453 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-18672 as depicted on map number 17453 which is made a part of this Order.

3. Appropriation A-18672 is held by Joseph R. Wubben and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 319.2 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from a tributary to Second Bow Creek at a point of diversion in the SE¹/₄SW¹/₄ of Section 6, Township 32 North, Range 2 East of the 6th P.M. in Cedar County, Nebraska, at a maximum rate of 4.56 cubic foot per second (cfs) (2,047 gallons per minute). The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated and an annual volume not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre irrigated.

4. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-18672.
