APPROVAL OF MAP 17755 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-18732

WATER DIVISION 1-C

BACKGROUND

On December 13, 2010, Paul E. Folkerts filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-18732 for a Permit to Appropriate Water and map number 17755 showing land proposed to be irrigated under this application.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 17755 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-18732 as depicted on map number 17755 which is made a part of this Order.

3. Appropriation A-18732 authorizes the appropriator the use of water for irrigation of the 200.4 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from the Little Blue River at a point of diversion located on the left bank in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 20, Township 4 North, Range 6 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Nuckolls County, at a maximum rate of 2.86 cubic feet per second (cfs) (1,284 gallons per minute).

4. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated nor the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry. Therefore, in any year when less than the maximum permitted acres are being irrigated, the quantity of water diverted at any time may be restricted to 1/70 cfs for each permitted acre being irrigated that year. This appropriation of water under any circumstance shall be limited annually to three acre-feet per acre of land on which water is actually and beneficially applied.
5. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-18732.
