APPROVAL OF EXPEDITED TRANSFER EXT-1863 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-2892B

WATER DIVISION 1-C

Background

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-2892B is held by Verlin L. Welch Trust No. 1 and Roberta Welch Trust No. 1 (Welch Trusts).
2. Appropriation A-2892B has a priority date of October 14, 1938, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 18.6 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Spring Branch at a point of diversion located on left bank of the stream in the SW¹/₄NW¹/₄ of Section 16, Township 1 North, Range 1 West of the 6th P.M. in Thayer County. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 140 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.13 cfs (58 gallons per minute).

3. On January 21, 2010, Verlin Welch, on behalf of Welch Trusts, filed in the Department application EXT-1863 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use for land authorized to be irrigated by appropriation A-2892B. On the same date Verlin Welch filed map number 17594 showing the land proposed to be irrigated under appropriation A-2892B through transfer EXT-1863.

Order

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Application EXT-1863 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use and map number 17594 are APPROVED.

2. Appropriation A-2892B through transfer EXT-1863 authorizes the use of water to irrigate 18.6 acres of land described below and depicted on map number 17594, which is made a part of this Order. The water may be diverted from Spring Branch at a point of diversion located on the left bank of the stream in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16, Township 1 North, Range 1 West of the 6th P.M. in Thayer County. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cfs for every 140 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.13 cfs (58 gallons per minute). The total volume may not exceed 3 acre-feet per irrigated acre per year.

3. All terms and conditions of appropriation A-2892B remain in effect unless specifically changed by this Order.
4. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. This includes, but is not limited to, the following:
- a. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
 - b. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
 - c. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.

Additional Information


Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations, any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources, or the provisions of this Approval may cause cancellation of part or all of this appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

Nebraska law provides that failure to use an appropriation for more than five consecutive years may result in cancellation of the appropriation.

This appropriation is not a guarantee that water will be available. Nebraska law gives priority to senior appropriations. This appropriation may be closed if there is insufficient water to satisfy senior appropriations.
