APPROVAL OF MAP 17869 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-18784

WATER DIVISION 1-C

BACKGROUND

1. On May 23, 2011, Wayne L. Garrison and Margaret S. Buglewicz filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-18784 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On June 13, 2011, Wayne L. Garrison and Margaret S. Buglewicz filed in the Department map number 17869 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-18784.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 17869 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-18784 as depicted on map number 17869 which is made a part of this Order.



3. Appropriation A-18784 authorizes the appropriator the use of water for irrigation of the 41.3 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from Elk Creek at a point of diversion in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 15, Township 3 North, Range 6 West of the 6th P.M. in Nuckolls County, at a maximum rate of 0.59 cubic foot per second (cfs) (265 gallons per minute).
4. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated nor the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry. Therefore, in any year when less than the maximum permitted acres are being irrigated, the quantity of water diverted at any time may be restricted to 1/70 cfs for each permitted acre being irrigated that year. This appropriation of water under any circumstance shall be limited annually to three acre-feet per acre of land on which water is actually and beneficially applied.

5. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-18784.
