APPROVAL OF MAP 18312 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-18964

WATER DIVISION 1-C

BACKGROUND

1. On September 10, 2012, Marilyn S. Corman filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-18964 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On November 19, 2012, Marilyn S. Corman filed map number 18312 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-18964.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 18312 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-18964 as depicted on map number 18312 which is made a part of this Order.



3. Appropriation A-18964 authorizes the appropriator the use of water for irrigation of the 43.2 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from the Little Blue River at a point of diversion on the right bank of the stream in the NE¹/₄NW¹/₄ of Section 34, Township 4 North, Range 6 West of the 6th P.M. in Nuckolls County, at a maximum rate of 0.62 cubic feet per second (cfs) (278 gallons per minute).
4. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated nor the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry. Therefore, in any year when less than the maximum permitted acres are being irrigated, the quantity of water diverted at any time may be restricted to 1/70 cfs for each permitted acre being irrigated that year. This appropriation of water under any circumstance shall be limited annually to three acre-feet per acre of land on which water is actually and beneficially applied.

5. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-18964.
