APPROVAL OF MAP 18374 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-18991

WATER DIVISION 1-D

BACKGROUND

1. On November 29, 2012, David G. and Deanne M. Reetz filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-18991 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On December 12, 2012, David G. and Deanne M. Reetz filed in the Department map number 18374 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-18991.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 18374 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-18991 as depicted on map number 18374 which is made a part of this Order.

Township 12 North, Range 1 West of the  
6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in York County Acres

Section 30: SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  18.3

3. Appropriation A-18991 has a priority date of November 29, 2012, and authorizes the appropriator the use of water for irrigation of the 18.3 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from Lincoln Creek at a point of diversion located on the right bank of the stream in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 30, Township 12 North, Range 1 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in York County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.26 cfs (117 gallons per minute).
4. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated nor the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry. Therefore, in any year when less than the maximum permitted acres are being irrigated, the quantity of water diverted at any time may be restricted to 1/70 cfs for each permitted acre being irrigated that year. This appropriation of water under any circumstance shall be limited annually to 3 acre-feet per acre of land on which water is actually and beneficially applied.

5. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-18991.
