APPROVAL OF APPLICATION A-18999

WATER DIVISION 1-D

BACKGROUND

1. On December 26, 2012, Darrell D. Bruns, on behalf of Sue A. Bruns and himself, filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-18999 for a permit to appropriate water from Wildcat Reservoir No. 1 for an amount not to exceed 14.0 acre-feet per year.
2. On December 26, 2012, Darrell D. Bruns also filed in the Department the following applications:
  - A. A-18996 for a permit to impound water in Wildcat Reservoir No. 1 for an amount not to exceed 14.0 acre-feet per year.
  - B. A-18998 for a permit to impound water in Wildcat Reservoir No. 2 from a different source for an amount not to exceed 14.0 acre-feet per year. Water stored in Wildcat Reservoir No. 2 would be released into a tributary to Wildcat Creek, travel down the natural channel and be withdrawn from Wildcat Reservoir No. 1.
  - C. A-19002 for a permit to appropriate water from the proposed Wildcat Reservoir No. 2 for the purpose of irrigation.
3. On January 26, 2013, Darrell D. Bruns filed in the Department map number 18395 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-18999.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that application A-18999 is APPROVED subject to the following limitations and conditions:

1. The source of water is Wildcat Reservoir No. 1, constructed under storage appropriation A-18996.
2. The water shall be used for the purpose of irrigation.
3. The priority date is December 26, 2012.
4. Only the land shown on map number 18395 may be irrigated under appropriation A-18999.
5. This appropriation will be limited to the land irrigated and the amount of water beneficially used on an annual basis. Such amount shall not exceed 14 acre-feet per annum.

6. This surface water appropriation shall provide supplemental water for land already included under natural-flow appropriation A-18745 held by Darrell D. and Sue A. Bruns.
7. A measuring device approved by the Department is required. All diversions of water under appropriations A-18745, A-18999 and A-19002 must be recorded by this device. By December 31<sup>st</sup> of each calendar year the appropriator shall file a report of the total amount of water diverted under appropriations A-18745, A-18999 and A-19002 in the Lincoln Field Office, Department of Natural Resources, P.O. Box 94676, Lincoln, Nebraska 68509-4676.
8. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. The statutes include, but are not limited to, the following:
  - A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
  - B. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
  - C. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.
9. The appropriator must comply with the following deadlines:
  - A. Construction of the diversion works must begin within twelve months of the signing date of this application approval. The appropriator must proceed diligently with the construction unless interrupted by some unavoidable and natural cause.
  - B. Construction of the project must be completed by two years past the signing date of this application approval.
  - C. The appropriation is not considered perfected until water has been beneficially applied for the purpose stated in this approval. The water appropriated under A-18999 must be beneficially used by September 1, 2015.
  - D. After September 1, 2015, a field investigation will be conducted to determine the acres irrigated, after which an order of cancellation will be issued for any unused portions of appropriation A-18999.


#### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations, any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources, or the provisions of this Approval may result in the cancellation of the appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

Nebraska law provides that failure to use a portion or all of a perfected appropriation for more than five consecutive years may result in cancellation of the appropriation.
