APPROVAL OF MAP 18518 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-19074

WATER DIVISION 2-B

BACKGROUND

1. On April 29, 2013, James Kubik filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-19074 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On June 3, 2013, James Kubik filed in the Department map number 18518 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-19074.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 18518 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-19074 as depicted on map number 18518 which is made a part of this Order.

Township 15 North, Range 5 East of the  
6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Saunders County Acres

Section 17: NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  0.5

3. Appropriation A-19074 has a priority date of April 29, 2013, and authorizes the appropriator the use of water for irrigation of the 0.5 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from the North Fork of Wahoo Creek at a point of diversion located on the right bank of the stream in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 17, Township 15 North, Range 5 East of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Saunders County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.01 cfs (4 gallons per minute).
4. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated nor the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry. Therefore, in any year when less than the maximum permitted acres are being irrigated, the quantity of water diverted at any time may be restricted to 1/70 cfs for each permitted acre being irrigated that year. This appropriation of water under any circumstance shall be limited annually to 3 acre-feet per acre of land on which water is actually and beneficially applied.

5. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-19074.
