APPROVAL OF EXPEDITED TRANSFER EXT-1887 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION D-1077

WATER DIVISION 2-F

Background

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation D-1077 is held by Foley Family Limited Partnership.
2. Appropriation D-1077 has a priority date of May 1, 1973, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 450.0 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from the Missouri River at points of diversion located in the SW¹/₄SE¹/₄ and the SE¹/₄SE¹/₄ of Section 6, Township 33 North, Range 1 East of the 6th P.M. in Cedar County. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 6.43 cfs from all points of diversion (2,886 gallons per minute).

3. On March 3, 2010, Robert Foley, on behalf of Foley Family Partnership, filed in the Department application EXT-1887 and map number 17615 showing the land proposed to be irrigated under appropriation D-1077 through EXT-1887.

Order

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Application EXT-1887 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use and map number 17615 are APPROVED.
2. Appropriation D-1077, through transfer EXT-1887, authorizes the use of water to irrigate 450.0 acres of land described below and depicted on map number 17615, which is made a part of this Order. The water may be diverted from the Missouri River at points of diversion located on the left bank of the stream in the SW¹/₄SE¹/₄ and the SE¹/₄SE¹/₄ of Section 6, Township 33 North, Range 1 East of the 6th P.M. in Cedar County. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 6.43 cfs from all points of diversion (2,886 gallons per minute). The total combined volume may not exceed 3 acre-feet per irrigated acre per year.

3. All terms and conditions of appropriation D-1077 remain in effect unless specifically changed by this Order.
4. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. This includes, but is not limited to, the following:
 - a. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
 - b. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).

- c. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.

Additional Information

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations, any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources, or the provisions of this Approval may cause cancellation of part or all of this appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

Nebraska law provides that failure to use an appropriation for more than five consecutive years may result in cancellation of the appropriation.

This appropriation is not a guarantee that water will be available. Nebraska law gives priority to senior appropriations. This appropriation may be closed if there is insufficient water to satisfy senior appropriations.
