ORDER DISMISSING APPLICATION TO DRILL A WATER WELL WITHOUT REGARD TO MINIMUM
STATUTORY SPACING


The Director of the Department of Natural Resources (Department) dismisses Application WSP-117, for a permit to drill an irrigation well within 600 feet of existing irrigation well G-011625, submitted by Gerald N and Alan Krienert.

Subsequent to the filing of Application WSP-117, Alan Krienert filed a change of ownership and a notice of water well decommissioning for irrigation well G-011625. Consequently, no permit to violate statutory spacing is required for the proposed well.

It is therefore ORDERED that Application WSP-117 is DISMISSED.
