APPROVAL OF MAP 18820 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-19190

WATER DIVISION 1-D

BACKGROUND

1. On February 4, 2014, the Lower Big Blue Natural Resources District, on behalf of landowner Andrew Sisco, filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-19190 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On April 30, 2014, Andrew Sisco filed in the Department map number 18820 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-19190.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 18820 is APPROVED.
2. The following is a description of all the land which is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-19190 as depicted on map number 18820:



3. Appropriation A-19190 authorizes the appropriator the use of 69.3 acre-feet annually from Plum Creek Reservoir 5B (storage appropriation A-13170) from a pump site located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 1, Township 2 North, Range 9 East of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Pawnee County, as depicted on map number 18820. Permission was given to divert water for irrigation from this reservoir by the Lower Big Blue Natural Resources District, the appropriator of A-13170.

4. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-19190.
