APPROVAL OF APPLICATION A-19192

WATER DIVISION 2-F

BACKGROUND

1. On September 8, 2013, Northern Natural Gas Company filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) an easement agreement for access to the point of diversion for appropriation A-19137.
2. On February 18, 2014, Northern Natural Gas Company filed in the Department application A-19192 for a temporary permit to appropriate water.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that application A-19192 is APPROVED subject to the following limitations and conditions:

1. The source of water is the Missouri River.
2. The water shall be used for the purpose of hydrostatic testing for pipeline construction.
3. The priority date is February 18, 2014.
4. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4, Township 27 North, Range 9 East of the 6th P.M. in Dakota County.
5. The rate that water may be diverted under appropriation A-19192 shall not exceed 2.67 cubic foot per second (1200 gallons per minute).
6. This appropriation EXPIRES one year from the date of this Order and appropriation A-19192 shall be CANCELLED without further action by the Department as of that date.
7. The easement filed by Northern Natural Gas Company on September 8, 2013, for appropriation A-19137 is sufficient for the purposes in this appropriation.

8. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. This includes, but is not limited to, the following:
- A. Receiving approval prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, a transfer of the location of the place of use, a relinquishment of a portion of the appropriation, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.
 - B. Comply with all relevant notices and orders of the Department.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations, any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources, or the provisions of this Approval may result in the cancellation of the appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

This appropriation is not a guarantee that water will be available. Nebraska law gives priority to senior appropriations. This appropriation may be closed if there is insufficient water to satisfy senior appropriations. If in the future you are not able to divert sufficient amounts of water, and if there are junior appropriations upstream, you may call for water by contacting your local field office.

The applicant and any person with sufficient legal interest who has been or may be substantially affected by this order may request a contested case hearing in accordance with the *Neb. Admin. Procedures Act* §§ 84-901 et. seq. RRS and the Department's *Rules of Practice and Procedure Title 454 Admin. Code Chapter 7*. The request must be received by the Department at its Lincoln office (Nebraska State Office Building, 4th Floor, 301 Centennial Mall South, P.O. Box 94676, Lincoln, Nebraska 68509-4676) within 30 days of the date of the order and be accompanied by a filing fee of \$10.
