ORDER OF DISMISSAL OF APPLICATION A-18983

FOR A PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE WATER

WATER DIVISION 2-F

BACKGROUND

1. On November 7, 2012, Lyle A. and Mary Ann Fischer filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-18983 for a permit to appropriate water from Bazile Creek for water for livestock located in the S $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, Township 29 North, Range 5 West of the 6th P.M. in Knox County.
2. On December 17, 2012, the Department requested additional information in order to process application A-18983. Pursuant to *Nebraska Revised Statutes* § 46-233(3) the corrected application must be returned within 90 days or the application will be dismissed.
3. A response was received on December 31, 2012, which did not provide all of the necessary information required to process application A-18983. As a consequence, the application is deemed to be incomplete and not corrected within the time period provided by statute. Therefore, it should be dismissed.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED application A-18983 is DISMISSED.
