APPROVAL OF APPLICATION CWG-5507 AND MAP 19327

FOR A PERMIT TO CONDUCT GROUNDWATER

WATER DIVISION 1-C

BACKGROUND

1. On July 20, 2015, Bryan Dake filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application CWG-5507 for a permit to conduct water from groundwater well G-176846 into Schlife Reservoir and remove a portion of the same water.
2. This application requests the act of conducting forty nine (49) gallons per minute of groundwater from G-176846. The Little Blue Natural Resources District was consulted and has no objections as long as the pump installed in groundwater well G-176846 produces less than fifty (50) gallons per minute and is not operating in series with other wells.
3. A review of Department records indicates that the registered pumping rate of groundwater well G-176846 is fourteen (14) gallons per minute and is not in series.
4. On August 31, 2015, Bryan Dake filed map number 19327 showing the project proposed under application CWG-5507.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that application CWG-5507 and map 19327 are APPROVED subject to the following limitations and conditions:

1. The source of water to be conducted is from groundwater well G-176846 located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33, Township 01 North, Range 02 West of the 6th P.M. in Thayer County.
2. The groundwater will be pumped and measured into an underground pipe located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33, Township 01 North, Range 02 West of the 6th P.M. in Thayer County at a rate of **14 gallons per minute, the registered pumping rate**, and will be released into Schlife Reservoir in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said legal description. Water will be withdrawn and metered from Schlife Reservoir at a rate of no more than **14 gallons per minute**.
3. The difference between the amount of groundwater being delivered into Schlife Reservoir and total amount of water being released will provide the amount of surface water withdrawn from Schlife Reservoir.

15. This permit may be cancelled if the permit holder fails to conduct water for more than five consecutive years.
16. Pursuant to *Neb. Rev. Stat. § 46-252*, the permit holder shall not be exempt from obtaining any other permits required by law.
