APPROVAL OF APPLICATION A-19440 AND MAP NUMBER 19552

WATER DIVISION 2-B

BACKGROUND

1. On May 18, 2016, Dale and Roberta Ruehling filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-19440 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On June 2, 2016, Dale and Roberta Ruehling filed in the Department map number 19552 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-19440.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that application A-19440 and map number 19552 are APPROVED subject to the following limitations and conditions:

1. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-19440 as depicted on map number 19552 which is made a part of this Order.

Township 23 North, Range 07 East of the  
6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Cuming County Acres

Section 06: SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  0.3

2. Appropriation A-19440 has a priority date of May 18, 2016, and authorizes the appropriator the use of 0.06 cubic foot per second (cfs) (25 gallons per minute) of water for domestic purposes on the 0.3 acre of land described above. The water may be diverted from a tributary to Little Logan Creek at a point of diversion located on the right bank of the stream in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 06, Township 23 North, Range 07 East of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Cuming County, as depicted on map number 19552.
3. Only the land shown on map number 19552 may be irrigated under appropriation A-19440.
4. A measuring device, approved by the Department, may be required if so ordered by the Department.
5. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. The statutes include, but are not limited to, the following:
  - A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.

- B. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
  - C. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.
6. The appropriator must comply with the following deadlines:
- A. Construction of the diversion works must begin within twelve months of the signing date of this application approval. The appropriator must proceed diligently with the construction unless interrupted by some unavoidable and natural cause.
  - B. Construction of the project must be completed by two years past the signing date of this application approval.
  - C. The appropriation is not considered perfected until water has been beneficially applied for the purpose stated in this approval. The water appropriated under A-19440 must be beneficially used by September 1, 2018.
  - D. After September 1, 2018, a field investigation will be conducted to determine the acres irrigated, after which an order of cancellation will be issued for any unused portions of appropriation A-19440.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION


Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations, any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources, or the provisions of this Approval may result in the cancellation of the appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

Nebraska law provides that failure to use a portion or all of a perfected appropriation for more than five consecutive years may result in cancellation of the appropriation.

This appropriation is not a guarantee that water will be available. Nebraska law gives priority to senior appropriations. This appropriation may be closed if there is insufficient water to satisfy senior appropriations. If in the future you are not able to divert sufficient amounts of water, and if there are junior appropriations upstream, you may call for water by contacting your local field office.

The applicant and any person with sufficient legal interest who has been or may be substantially affected by this order may request a contested case hearing in accordance with the *Neb. Admin. Procedures Act* §§ 84-901 et. seq. RRS and the Department's *Rules of Practice and Procedure Title 454 Admin. Code Chapter 7*. The request must be received by the Department at its Lincoln office (Nebraska State Office Building, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, 301 Centennial Mall South, P.O. Box 94676, Lincoln, Nebraska 68509-4676) within 30 days of the date of the order and be accompanied by a filing fee of \$10.
