ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-12403C

WATER DIVISION 1-D

Background

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-12403C is held by the United States Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS).
2. Appropriation A-12403C authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 3.25 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from a tributary to School Creek at a point of diversion located on the left bank of the stream in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12, Township 7 North, Range 8 West of the 6th P.M. in Clay County. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.05 cfs.


