APPROVAL OF APPLICATION A-18661

WATER DIVISION 1-D

Background

1. On April 22, 2009, Matthew J. Young, filed application A-18661 in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On April 28, 2009, Matthew J. Young filed map number 17407 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-18661.

Order

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that application A-18661 is APPROVED subject to the following limitations and conditions:

1. The source of water is Coon Creek.
2. The water shall be used for domestic purposes.
3. The priority date is April 22, 2009.
4. Only the land shown on map number 17407 may be irrigated under appropriation A-18661.
5. The rate that water may be diverted under appropriation A-18661 shall not exceed one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated. Total annual volume of water diverted may not exceed 3 acre-feet per acre irrigated.
6. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. This includes, but is not limited to, the following:
 - a. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
 - b. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
 - c. Getting approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.
