APPROVAL OF MAP 17437 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-18666

WATER DIVISION 2-C

Background

1. On May 26, 2009, Larry L. and Marilyn K. Frank filed application A-18666 in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On June 17, 2009, Larry L. and Marilyn K. Frank filed map number 17437 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-18666.

Order

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 17437 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-18666 as depicted on map number 17437 which is made a part of this Order.

3. Appropriation A-18666 is held by Larry L. and Marilyn K. Frank and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 87.9 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from the North Branch of Verdigre Creek at a point of diversion in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 1, Township 30 North, Range 8 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Knox County. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 1.26 cubic foot per second (cfs) (565 gallons per minute). The annual volume may not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre irrigated.
