APPROVAL OF APPLICATION A-18683

WATER DIVISION 1-D

Background

1. On November 30, 2009, the Lower Big Blue Natural Resources District (District), on behalf of Lawrence Gronewold, landowner, filed application A-18683 in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On January 21, 2010, Lawrence Gronewold filed map number 17584 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-18683.

Order

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that application A-18683 is APPROVED subject to the following limitations and conditions:

1. The source of water is Bear Creek Reservoir 6-B, constructed under storage appropriation A-10833.
2. The water shall be used for the purpose of irrigation.
3. The priority date is November 30, 2009.
4. Only the land shown on map number 17584 may be irrigated under appropriation A-18683.
5. The appropriator is responsible for ensuring the embankment of Bear Creek Reservoir 6-B's dam (storage appropriation A-10833) is not disturbed, or otherwise affected, by the irrigation activity under this appropriation.
6. This appropriation will be limited to the land irrigated and the amount of water beneficially used on an annual basis. Such amount shall not exceed 50.0 acre-feet per annum.
7. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. This includes, but is not limited to, the following:
  - a. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
  - b. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).

- c. Getting approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.

Deadlines

1. Construction of the diversion works must begin within twelve months of the signing date of this application approval. The appropriator must proceed diligently with the construction unless interrupted by some unavoidable and natural cause.
2. Construction of the project must be completed by two years past the signing date of this application approval.
3. The appropriation is not considered perfected until water has been beneficially applied for the purpose stated in this approval. September 1, 2012, is the date by which the water appropriated under A-18683 must have been used.
4. After September 1, 2012, a field investigation will be conducted to determine the amount of water used and acres irrigated, after which an order of cancellation will be issued for any unused portions of appropriation A-18683.


Additional Information

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations, any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources, or the provisions of this Approval may result in the cancellation of the appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

Nebraska law provides that failure to use a portion or all of a perfected appropriation for more than five consecutive years may result in cancellation of the appropriation.
