APPROVAL OF MAP 17651 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-18689

WATER DIVISION 1-D

Background

1. On February 22, 2010, W. Gene George, on behalf of Joanne George, landowner, filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-18689 for a Permit to appropriate Water.
2. On April 29, 2010, W. Gene George filed map number 17651 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-18689.

Order

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 17651 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-18689 as depicted on map number 17651 which is made a part of this Order.

Township 10 North, Range 6 West of the
6th P.M. in Hamilton County Acres


Section 14: SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 20.4

3. Appropriation A-18689 is held by Joanne George and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 20.4 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from Beaver Creek at a point of diversion on both banks in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, Township 10 North, Range 6 West of the 6th P.M. in Hamilton County, at a maximum rate of 0.29 cubic foot per second (cfs) (130 gallons per minute) from all points of diversion. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated and an annual volume not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre irrigated.

4. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-18689.
