APPROVAL OF MAP 17765 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-18734

WATER DIVISION 1-D

BACKGROUND

1. On January 14, 2011, DeVern C. and June K. Hagemeyer filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-18734 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On April 11, 2011, DeVern C. Hagemeyer filed map number 17765 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-18734.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 17765 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-18734 as depicted on map number 17765 which is made a part of this Order.

3. Appropriation A-18734 authorizes the appropriator the use of water for irrigation of the 168.3 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from Clatonia Creek at points of diversion in the SE¹/₄SE¹/₄ of Section 32 and the SW¹/₄SW¹/₄ of Section 33, both in Township 6 North, Range 5 East of the 6th P.M. in Gage County, at a maximum combined rate of 2.40 cubic foot per second (cfs) (1,077 gallons per minute) from all points of diversion.

4. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated nor the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry. Therefore, in any year when less than the maximum permitted acres are being irrigated, the quantity of water diverted at any time may be restricted to 1/70 cfs for each permitted acre being irrigated that year. This appropriation of water under any circumstance shall be limited annually to three acre-feet per acre of land on which water is actually and beneficially applied.
5. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-18734.
