APPROVAL OF MAP 18067 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-18865

WATER DIVISION 1-D

BACKGROUND

1. On January 13, 2012, Thomas M. and Pamela J. Russell filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-18865 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On February 2, 2012, Thomas M. Russell filed map number 18067 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-18865.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 18067 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-18865 as depicted on map number 18067 which is made a part of this Order.

Township 8 North, Range 9 West of the
6th P.M. in Adams County Acres

Section 25: SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 33.9

3. Appropriation A-18865 authorizes the appropriator the use of water for irrigation of the 33.9 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from the West Fork of the Big Blue River at a point of diversion in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25, Township 8 North, Range 9 West of the 6th P.M. in Adams County, at a maximum rate of 0.48 cubic foot per second (cfs) (215 gallons per minute).
4. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated nor the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry. Therefore, in any year when less than the maximum permitted acres are being irrigated, the quantity of water diverted at any time may be restricted to 1/70 cfs for each permitted acre being irrigated that year. This appropriation of water under any circumstance shall be limited annually to three acre-feet per acre of land on which water is actually and beneficially applied.

5. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-18865.
