APPROVAL OF MAP 18074 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-18866

WATER DIVISION 1-D

BACKGROUND

1. On January 23, 2012, Donald C. Schuller and Mary J. Grummert filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-18866 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On June 12, 2012, Donald C. Schuller and Mary J. Grummert filed in the Department map number 18074 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-18866.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 18074 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-18866 as depicted on map number 18074 which is made a part of this Order.

3. Appropriation A-18866 authorizes the appropriator the use of water for irrigation of the 137.0 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from the Big Blue River at a point of diversion on the left bank of the stream located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 35, Township 2 North, Range 7 East of the 6th P.M. in Gage County, at a maximum rate of 1.96 cubic feet per second (cfs) (880 gallons per minute).

4. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated nor the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry. Therefore, in any year when less than the maximum permitted acres are being irrigated, the quantity of water diverted at any time may be restricted to 1/70 cfs for each permitted acre being irrigated that year. This appropriation of water under any circumstance shall be limited annually to three acre-feet per acre of land on which water is actually and beneficially applied.
5. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-18866.
