ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-12122 AND Plan P-10722

WATER DIVISION 1-D

BACKGROUND


1. Plan number P-10722 for surface water appropriation A-12122, was approved by the Department of Natural Resources (Department) on December 4, 1970.
2. Appropriation A-12122 has a priority date of November 30, 1970, and can store 15.9 acre-feet of water from a Tributary to Beaver Creek in Peetzke Dam, located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 5, Township 10 North, Range 5 West of the 6th P.M. in Hamilton County.
3. On September 8, 2011, a field investigation was performed in response to a phone call made to the Department indicating that Peetzke dam had been removed. It was determined that the Peetzke dam and reservoir has been removed and the land at that location is now being farmed.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED appropriation A-12122 and plan number P-10722 are CANCELLED.
