ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER

APPROPRIATIONS A-17864A, A-17864B AND A-17864C

WATER DIVISION 2-B

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriations A-17864A, A-17864B and A-17864C are held by Rick L. and Karen M. Beranek.
2. Appropriation A-17864A has a priority date of June 6, 2000, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 95 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Wahoo Creek at points of diversion located on the left bank of the stream in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20, Township 13 North, Range 9 East of the 6th P.M. in Saunders County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 140 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 0.68 cfs from all points of diversion.

3. Appropriation A-17864B has a priority date of June 6, 2000, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 2 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Wahoo Creek at points of diversion located on the left bank of the stream in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20, Township 13 North, Range 9 East of the 6th P.M. in Saunders County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 140 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 0.01 cfs from all points of diversion.

4. Appropriation A-17864C has a priority date of June 6, 2000, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 16 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Wahoo Creek at points of diversion located on the left bank of the stream in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20, Township 13 North, Range 9 East of the 6th P.M. in Saunders County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 0.23 cfs from all points of diversion.

5. On January 31, 2014, Rick L. and Karen M. Beranek filed Relinquishments of Water Appropriation, REL-4922, REL-4923 and REL-4924, in the office of the Department relinquishing the right to divert water under appropriations A-17864A, A-17864B and A-17864C, respectively, for use upon the land described above.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED appropriations A- A-17864A, A-17864B and A-17864C are CANCELLED.
