ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-17926

WATER DIVISION 1-D

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-17926 is held by Willard E. and Opal G. Rule. The Department of Natural Resources has received information that Willard E. Rule is deceased.
2. A search of the records of the Pawnee County Register of Deeds indicates the land appurtenant to appropriation A-17926 includes names of owners that are different than the owner listed in Department records. These individuals are James E. Rule, Clarence D. Rule and Clinton W. Rule.
3. Appropriation A-17926 has a priority date of October 27, 2000, and authorizes the use of water for the purpose of fish culture. The water may be diverted from Wolf Creek at points of diversion located on the right bank of the stream in Section 8, Township 2 North, Range 9 East of the 6th P.M. in Pawnee County. The amount of water diverted shall not exceed 77.5 acre-feet per annum at a maximum rate of 1.79 cubic feet per second.
4. On April 17, 2012, Opal G. Rule, James Rule, Clarence Rule and Clinton Rule filed a Relinquishment of Water Appropriation, REL-2314, in the office of the Department relinquishing the right to divert water under appropriation A-17926 for use upon the land described above.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED appropriation A-17926 is CANCELLED.
