APPROVAL OF MAP 17802 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-18752

WATER DIVISION 1-D

BACKGROUND

1. On March 3, 2011, the Lower Big Blue Natural Resources District, on behalf of landowners Bruce and Elizabeth Daubendiek, filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-18752 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On May 23, 2011, Bruce and Elizabeth Daubendiek filed map number 17802 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-18752.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 17802 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-18752 as depicted on map number 17802 which is made a part of this Order.

Township 5 North, Range 7 East of the 6 th P.M. in Gage County	Acres

3. Appropriation A-18752 authorizes the appropriator to divert water in the amount of 63.1 acre-feet annually for irrigation of the 80 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from points of diversion on both banks of the Bear-Pierce-Cedar 3-A Reservoir in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, Township 5 North, Range 7 East of the 6th P.M. in Gage County with the permission of the Lower Big Blue Natural Resources District, appropriator of storage appropriation A-11038.

4. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-18752.
