APPROVAL OF MAP 17823 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-18762

WATER DIVISION 2-C

BACKGROUND

On March 21, 2011, Rodney M. and Diane Heiss filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-18762 for a Permit to Appropriate Water and map number 17823 showing land proposed to be irrigated under this application.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 17823 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-18762 as depicted on map number 17823 which is made a part of this Order.



3. Appropriation A-18762 authorizes the appropriator the use of water for irrigation of the 118 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from a tributary to the Middle Branch of Verdigre Creek at a point of diversion in the SE¹/₄NE¹/₄ of Section 11, Township 29 North, Range 9 West of the 6th P.M. in Holt County, at a maximum rate of 1.69 cubic feet per second (cfs) (758 gallons per minute).
4. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated nor the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry. Therefore, in any year when less than the maximum permitted acres are being irrigated, the quantity of water diverted at any time may be restricted to 1/70 cfs for each permitted acre being irrigated that year. This appropriation of water under any circumstance shall be limited annually to three acre-feet per acre of land on which water is actually and beneficially applied.

5. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-18762.
