APPROVAL OF MAP 17874 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-18787

WATER DIVISION 1-D

BACKGROUND

1. On May 31, 2011, Harold Stokebrand filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-18787 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On June 8, 2011, Harold Stokebrand filed map number 17874 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-18787.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 17874 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-18787 as depicted on map number 17874 which is made a part of this Order.

Township 5 North, Range 4 East of the  
6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Saline County Acres

Section 4: NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  2.2

3. Appropriation A-18787 authorizes the appropriator the use of water for irrigation of the 2.2 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from Turkey Creek at a point of diversion in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 4, Township 5 North, Range 4 East of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Saline County, at a maximum rate of 0.03 cubic foot per second (cfs) (13 gallons per minute).
4. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated nor the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry. Therefore, in any year when less than the maximum permitted acres are being irrigated, the quantity of water diverted at any time may be restricted to 1/70 cfs for each permitted acre being irrigated that year. This appropriation of water under any circumstance shall be limited annually to three acre-feet per acre of land on which water is actually and beneficially applied.

5. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-18787.


