APPROVAL OF MAP 18793 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-19180

WATER DIVISION 1-C

BACKGROUND

On January 27, 2014, Kenneth D. Milius filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-19180 for a Permit to Appropriate Water and map number 18793 showing land proposed to be irrigated under this application.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 18793 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-19180 as depicted on map number 18793 which is made a part of this Order.

Township 3 North, Range 1 East of the
6th P.M. in Jefferson County Acres

Section 23: NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 5

3. Appropriation A-19180 has a priority date of January 27, 2014, and authorizes the appropriator the use of water for irrigation of the 5 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from the Little Blue River at a point of diversion located on the left bank of the stream in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23, Township 3 North, Range 1 East of the 6th P.M. in Jefferson County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.07 cfs (31 gallons per minute).
4. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated nor the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry. Therefore, in any year when less than the maximum permitted acres are being irrigated, the quantity of water diverted at any time may be restricted to 1/70 cfs for each permitted acre being irrigated that year. This appropriation of water under any circumstance shall be limited annually to 3 acre-feet per acre of land on which water is actually and beneficially applied; not to exceed the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry.

5. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-19180.

Box 94676, Lincoln, Nebraska 68509-4676) within 30 days of the date of the order and be accompanied by a filing fee of \$10.
