APPROVAL OF APPLICATION CWG-2198

FOR A PERMIT TO CONDUCT GROUND WATER AND MAP NUMBER 18016

WATER DIVISION 1-D

Background

1. On October 26, 2011, Delfred and Sara Schlake filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application CWG-2198 for a permit to conduct groundwater into a reservoir and remove a portion of the same water from said reservoir.
2. On December 13, 2011, Delfred Schlake filed map number 18016 showing land proposed to be irrigated under conduct water permit CWG-2198.

Order

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Application CWG-2198 and map number 18016 are hereby APPROVED.
2. The source of water to be conducted is from groundwater well G-154849 located in the N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, Township 2 North, Range 7 East of the 6th P.M. in Gage County.
3. The groundwater will be released into Schlake Reservoir (Storage appropriation A-17875) in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, Township 2 North, Range 7 East of the 6th P.M. in Gage County at a rate of 800 gallons per minute and will be withdrawn from the same reservoir at no more than a rate of 800 gallons per minute. The water will be withdrawn from a pump site located on the right bank of the reservoir in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, Township 2 North, Range 7 East of the 6th P.M. in Gage County.
4. The following is a description of all the land which can be irrigated (appurtenant land) with water conducted under CWG-2198 as depicted on map number 18016:



5. Measuring devices, approved by the Department, are **required** at the point of release into the reservoir **and** the point of withdrawal from the reservoir.
6. The permit holder is liable for any damages resulting from the overflow of Schlake Reservoir when water conducted contributes to an overflow.
7. This permit approves the act of conducting water. Use of water being conducted is authorized by the Lower Big Blue Natural Resources District.
8. This permit may be cancelled if the permit holder fails to conduct water for more than five consecutive years.

Procedures Act* §§ 84-901 et. seq. RRS and the Department's *Rules of Practice and Procedure* 454 *Neb. Admin. Code* Chapter 7. The request must be received by the Department at its Lincoln office (Nebraska State Office Building, 4th Floor, 301 Centennial Mall South, P.O. Box 94676, Lincoln, Nebraska 68509-4676) within 30 days of the date of the Approval and be accompanied by a filing fee of \$10.
