# Initial Ice Report 12/31/2016 through 1/6/2017:

# Summary (1/6/2017)

This week has seen the temperatures plummet as predicted by the NWS. The main channel remained 90% open throughout Sarpy County with some frazil and frazil pans noted. The Platte near the Hwy 6 bridge by Ashland showed 40% of the channel with frazil ice variations while the southern end by Louisville had a 95% open channel flowing. The Union Dike area was frozen over on Wednesday at the time of observation. Next week's forecast again shows a warming trend with little or no precipitation expected.

NO ICE JAMMING AT THIS TIME on the East end of the State.

### PM4 - Douglas County, on the Platte Hwy 92

Temperature was 9 degrees Fahrenheit and winds out of the north at 15 mph. Channel is 50% open with about 10ft of boarder ice accumulated near the shore. West side of the channel is open and the east side is frozen and intact ice at this time.

#### P7 - Sarpy County, on the Platte Hwy 31 at 204 St.

Temperature was 11°F. The average wind speed was 14 mph (NW). It was estimated that it was less than feet bank full at this location. The channel remains 90%. It was noted: "Plate River channel is 90% clear with less than 5% frazil and frazil pans floating. Current stage and flow 3.42ft 5.64kcfs"

# PM7 - Douglas County, on the Platte Union Dike, 1/4 mile west of Hwy 275 & 3.1 miles upstream of Hwy 64 Lat: 41:21:40 Long: 96:25:00 (Wed Jan 4 2017 at 905am CDT)

Temperature was 9 degrees Fahrenheit and winds out of the north at 15 mph. Channel is 100% frozen over on the Platte at this time and location with water pockets across the channel.

## P9 - Sarpy County, on the Platte Hwy 6 & Platte River Bridge (Linoma)

Temperature was 11°F. The average wind speed was 15 mph (N). It was estimated that it was less than feet bank full at this location. The channel remains 90%. It was noted: "Plate River channel is 90% clear with less than 5% frazil and frazil pans floating. Current stage and flow 16.08ft 7.32kcfs"
