

Summary of Lower Platte & Elkhorn Rivers

Initial Ice Report 1/26/2022 through 2/4/2022:

Ice Jams are not present, at this time, on the eastern part of Nebraska. Fluctuating temperatures in the next week could cause break up of ice in areas.

Platte/Elkhorn

E1 - Sarpy County, on the Platte/Elkhorn Confluence of Platte and Elkhorn Rivers

Latitude: 41:8:0 Longitude: 96:19:0 (Wednesday, January 26 , 2022 @ 2:40 PM)

Temperature was 8°F. The average wind speed was 6 mph (SE). It is estimated that less than N/A feet bank full at this location. The channel remains 40%. It was noted: "Platte River is ice covered. The Elkhorn is 40% open extending about 1000 ft upstream from the confluence and going downstream along the east bank. Open water in the Elkhorn has minimal frazil slush."

PM4 - Douglas County, Hwy 92

Latitude: 41:14:2 Longitude: 96:21:55 (Wednesday, February 2, 2022 @ 3:54 PM)

Temperature was 10°F. The average wind speed was 14 mph (N). It is estimated that less than N/A feet bank full at this location. It was noted: "The west channel has an open channel along the west bank, approximately 20 ft wide with no moving ice. There is an channel downstream of the bridge extending approximately 500 upstream. The east channel is 100% ice covered."
